

In addition to the guidelines for each specific scholarship, the following is important information for all scholarships:

- » Scholarships will be adjusted for any changes in enrollment such as dropping courses or dropping the program.
- » Scholarship recipients must maintain satisfactory academic progress throughout the duration of the scholarship award.
- » Satisfactory academic progress is defined as:
 - Grade average of at least a “C”. In some cases, satisfactory academic progress may be defined differently in career majors or courses for which special grading scales exist to meet state or national certifications or other special requirements. Requirements are defined in the applicable instructors’ syllabi.
 - Completing work at a pace that will enable the student to complete the career major in the length of time specified in the school catalog.
- » Tulsa Tech Scholarships will not be automatically renewed. The student must submit an application, complete the FAFSA, and be eligible for each school year he or she applies.

Accelerating Independence (AI) Scholarship & Tulsa Works Scholarship

- » The scholarship is limited to tuition only and the student is responsible for additional fees, books, equipment, tools, uniforms, and supplies.
- » You must apply and meet all eligibility requirements each school year. If you turn 24 years old before starting the 2nd year of your program, a separate notice will be sent to you.
- » The Tulsa Works Scholarship is limited to one program.
- » The student must maintain continuous enrollment throughout the duration of the scholarship.
- » The scholarship will be adjusted if the student receives any outside scholarship or grants that must be applied towards tuition only.
- » The scholarship cannot be used for retaking classes.

CTSO Scholarship

- » The CTSO Scholarship must be used within 2 academic years following:
 - The competition in which the award was received,
 - Completion of a program in which the adult student is currently enrolled, or
 - Graduation from high school for secondary students.
- » The CTSO scholarship can only be applied to tuition charges incurred following the semester in which the scholarship is awarded.
- » The CTSO Scholarship cannot be used to refund previously charged or paid tuition.

Financial Needs Scholarship

- » The Financial Needs Scholarship is for students who are not eligible for Pell Grant
- » Have an Expected Family Contribution number from the FAFSA under \$8,000
- » Not in default on any federal student loans.

Partner School Scholarship

- » The Partner School Scholarship will cover tuition, up to \$2500, for one academic year.
- » If the program is longer than one academic year, the scholarship cannot be used for the 2nd year of the program.

Pathways Scholarship

The Pathways scholarship may cover up to 100% of tuition and required books for diversified population students. It may cover up to 25-50% of tuition and 100% of required books for displaced homemakers and careers unlimited students.
