Applicants must express an active interest in obtaining a high school diploma and pursuing career training in programs currently available through Tulsa Tech. Students spend half of each day earning high school credit recovery or "first time" credits through a combination of teacher-led instruction and online learning. The remaining half of each day is spent developing skills for a future career at any Tulsa Tech campus.

The Career Academy staff recognizes everyone learns differently. This all-inclusive program is designed to engage, educate, and expand opportunities for a wide range of students, as well as provide guidance and support toward a path to success.
